Scientific posters should fit into the 54” (H) x 24” (W) format. **A maximum of two abstracts would be accepted for each first author.**

Besides the prestigious awards for outstanding oral and poster presentations for the “Pre-Academy Fellows”, special prizes will also be presented in the well-received programme, “Residents’ challenge”.

Abstracts of sufficient quality work will also be published in the supplement issue of the Hong Kong Journal of Ophthalmology.

Enclosed, please also find the Registration Form. You are encouraged to submit your registration before 18th September 2009, as a special rate is available for ‘early birds’.
